FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the main benefit of giving my horse Rosehip?

Biochemists report that Vitamin C and Bioflavonoids work together synergistically to support the membranes of the capillaries and cells. Suggested uses include;

How often should I give my horse Rosehip?

Rosehip should be administered daily as part of your horse's overall health care regimen.

What is the best dosage for me to give my horse?

Rosehip should be administered at meal time. Dosage is one scoop (20 grams) daily for maintenance. If you are looking to accelerate the benefits of Rosehip, administer two scoops (40 grams) daily for 30 days to load.

Is Rosehip safe to be given to all types of horses?

Yes, Rosehip is safe for all types of horses from backyard to Olympic show ring and all activities in between. It should not be used if your horse has been diagnosed with a blood disorders. Read complete label declaration before using. If uncertain, always consult your veterinarian or health care professional.

Will Rosehip cause my horse to test positive for drugs?

No, our Rosehip is 100% Certified Organic and does not contain any components that would cause adverse testing results.

When giving my horse this product, should I reduce the amount of feed they are receiving?

No, this is not a feed product. This is what is called a dosage form animal health product that falls into the FDA/CVM (Food and Drug Administration/Center for Veterinary Medicine) category providing structure function health benefits versus feed associated nutritional benefits.

What is the definition of a Dosage Form Animal Health Product?

Defined as "...tablet, capsule, powder, or liquid form " Considered drugs because they are intended to prevent/treat disease, or affect the structure/function of the animal other than providing nutrition, taste, or aroma.

Is this product organic?

Yes, our Rosehip is 100% Organic and is certified by Kiwa BCS Öko – Garantie GmbH and is produced according to organic production methods in compliance with the USDA-NOP. Our product is all natural and contains no preservatives or fillers of any kind.

Is Rosehip a powder?

No, Rosehip is not a powder. It is a very fine grain and is comprised of 98% peels and 2% seeds.
